Dean Angeles (orchestra director), Professor Emeritus of Loyola University New Orleans, has served as conductor or clinician in 33 states, including 22 all-state orchestra festivals and numerous university summer music clinics. Over the course of his career, Dean has developed highly acclaimed public school string programs, coordinated a comprehensive teacher training program for the Loyola College of Music in New Orleans, and served as orchestra director at the Muziek-en-Sportkampen in Belgium.

Dr. Gina Caldwell (violin/viola) is a graduate of the North Carolina School for the Arts (BM), Boston University (MM), and Catholic University of America (DMA). Before returning to North Carolina and founding Joyful Noise, Caldwell was professor of violin and viola at Shepherd University (WV) and Atlantic Union College (MA) and director of the String Department for the Arts Education for Children Group (Maui). Caldwell has performed solo and chamber recitals as well as taught master classes across the United States and Costa Rica. She has taught students of all ages for 20 years, has performed with numerous orchestras across North Carolina, and is currently a member of the Asheville Symphony.

Kara Poorbaugh (viola) serves as Principal Violist of the Asheville Symphony and is a founding member of the Opal String Quartet. Kara also performs with the Greenville Symphony, Hendersonville Symphony, and Spartanburg Philharmonic. She is a graduate of the Eastman School of Music (BM-performance and music education) and teaches viola, violin, cello, and chamber music at Joyful Noise.

Daniel Weiser (camp director) holds a Doctorate in Piano/Chamber Music from the Peabody Conservatory, and has performed on many great stages throughout the US, Europe, Asia, and the Middle East. He has been on the music faculty of Dartmouth College and St. Paul's School (NH), and is the co-founder and Artistic Director of Classicopia, a chamber music organization based in New Hampshire, for which he also directed a summer music camp. Daniel has served as the Music Director of the Da Corneta Opera Ensemble, the Opera North Young Artist program, and Opera New England.

Franklin Keel (cello) is Associate Principal Cellist of the Asheville Symphony Orchestra and a founding member of the Opal String Quartet. He has appeared as a soloist with the Hendersonville Symphony Orchestra and the Symphony of the United Nations, and is a graduate of the Eastman School of Music. Franklin is currently pursuing a master's degree in music education at Appalachian State University and also performs outside the classical genre with numerous bands & artists including Sirius.B and Silas Durocher.

Frances Hsieh (violin) is a member of the Charleston Symphony and a graduate of Duke University (BA-Music and Biology) and Eastman School of Music (MM), where she toured Austria and Italy as a member of the Eastman Quartet and performed with the Rochester Philharmonic as an orchestral studies fellow. She has won positions and performed with numerous other orchestras including the North Carolina Symphony, and most recently won the position of Assistant Concertmaster with the Asheville Symphony.
